



## GRANGE EMBLEM SCARF

SIX

**STRAND FLOSS:** 6 skeins

Bright Gold, 3 skeins

Steel

Blue and 2 skeins each

Gold

Brown and

Baby Blue.

Tapestry Needle No. 22.

½ yard of white hardanger, 42 inches wide.

Cut hardanger along thread 15¾ x 42 inches. Place a pin ¼ inch in from corner. This is starting point A on chart 2.

**NOTE:** Each square on chart 2 represents 5 x 5 double threads.

**Embroidery:** Use 6 strands throughout. Design is worked in cross stitch and straight stitch as indicated on color key. When making cross stitches, top strands should all point in the same direction. Starting at A, follow chart 2 and color key for embroidery, being careful to make each cross stitch over 5 x 5 double threads. Make a ¼-inch hem all around scarf, mitering corners.

## FILET CROCHET GRANGE EMBLEM —

**CROCHET,**  
of White,  
Cream

**MERCERIZED**  
Size 30: 2 balls  
Ecru

Steel Crochet Hook No. 10.

**GAUGE:** 5 bls or sps = 1 inch; 5 rows = 1 inch.

Size: 14 x 15½ inches.

### EMBLEM

Make a chain 16 inches long (15 ch sts to 1 inch). 1st row: Starting at "A" on chart 1, dc in 8th ch from hook—sp made; \* ch 2, skip 2 ch, dc in next ch—another sp made. Repeat from \* across until there are 71 sps on row. Cut off remaining chain. Ch 5, turn. 2nd row: Skip first dc, dc in 2nd dc—sp over sp made; \* 2 dc in next sp, dc in dc—bl over sp made. Repeat from \* across to within last sp, ch 2, skip 2 ch, dc in next ch—sp over sp made. Ch 5, turn. 3rd row: Dc in 2nd dc, dc in 3 dc—bl over bl made; \* ch 2, skip 2 dc, dc in next dc—sp over bl made. Repeat from \* across to within last bl, dc in 3 dc, ch 2, skip 2 ch, dc in next ch. Ch 5, turn. Starting with 4th row, follow chart 1 until 78th row has been completed. Break off and fasten.

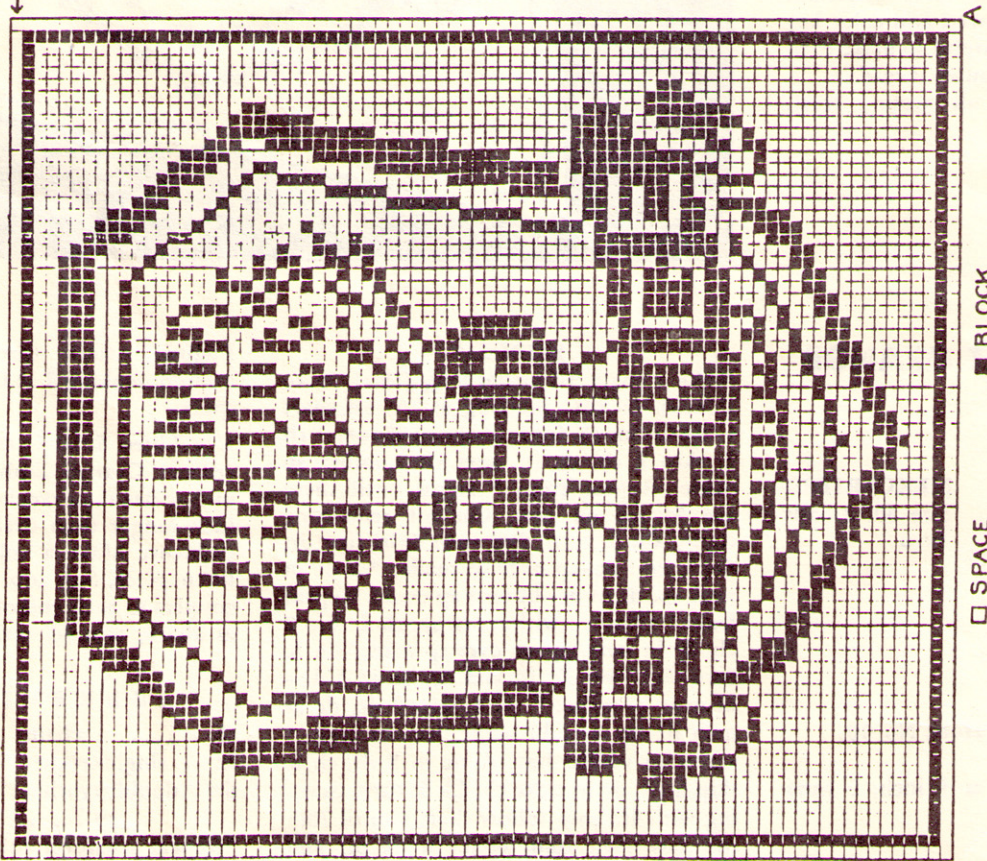
**Edging:** Attach thread and sc closely around, making 7 sc in each of the corner spaces.

**If a Linen Scarf is Desired:** Make 2 filet crochet Grange Emblems. Cut linen ½ inch wider than crocheted emblems and ½ inch longer than desired length between emblems. Make a rolled hem all around linen piece. Sew top edge of a crocheted emblem to each end of linen. Work edging as above, around entire piece.

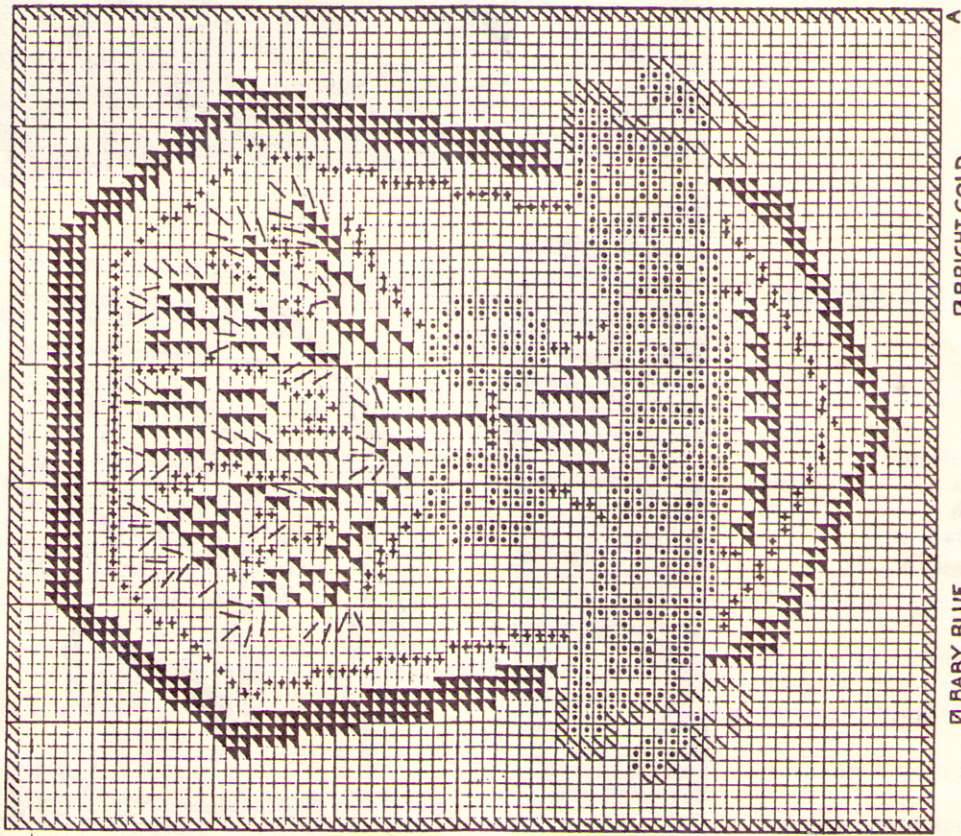
